Montana Coal Board Grant Program

Intro: The Montana Coal Board Grant Program provides financial assistance in the form of grants to enable local jurisdictions to adequately provide for the expansion of public services or facilities needed as a direct consequence of coal development activities, including coal mines or coal-using energy complexes, or resulting from a major decline in those activities. The Coal Board provides grants to assist local governmental units in planning for and meeting the needs for a variety of public facilities or services.

1. Incorporated cities and towns
2. Counties
3. School districts
4. Water & Sewer districts
5. State agencies
6. Tribal governments
